Our sector is a patchwork of small organisations. 66% of the organisations in our sector have an annual income of under £250,000.

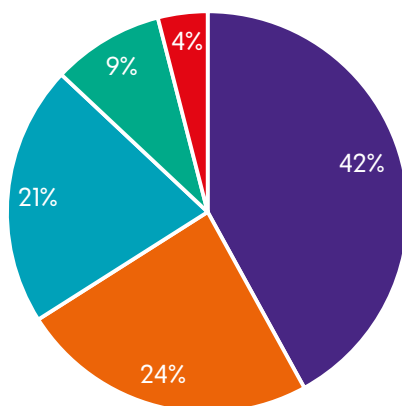

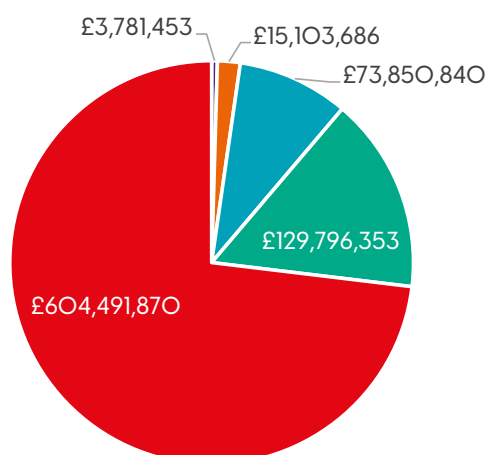

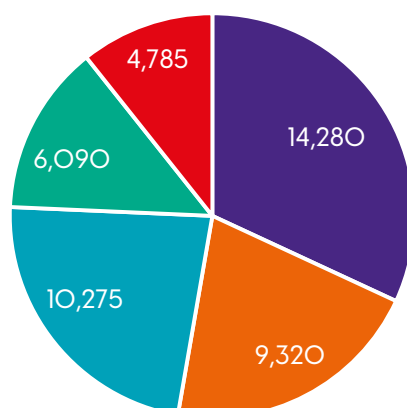
Organisation size by annual income (%)



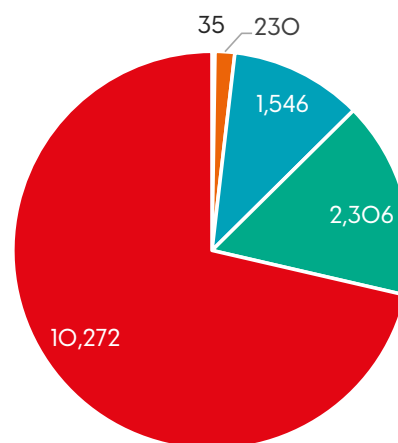
Estimated total income
